The Board of Directors (the "Board" or "Directors") of Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 36 (the "District") met in regular session at 4:03 p.m. at 903 Hollywood, Houston, Texas 77015 on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, pursuant to notice of said meeting posted in accordance with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. All members of the Board were present, thus constituting a quorum. Upon motion by Director Cantu, seconded by Director Holder, after full discussion and with all Directors present voting aye, the Board approved the issuance of a Notice of Award to CFG, Execution of the Construction Contract subject to attorney review, and issuance of the Notice to Proceed subject to Execution of the Construction Contract.

Upon motion by Director Eason, seconded by Director Koukoulakis, after full discussion and with all Directors present voting aye, the Board approved the Engineer's Report.

- 7. <u>General Manager's Report</u>. Ms. Duncan presented and reviewed with the Board the General Manager's Report, a copy of which is attached as <u>Exhibit "E"</u>.
- a. Ms. Duncan updated the Board regarding the District's current operations and ongoing projects.
- b. <u>Consideration and Possible Action to outsource bill printing and mail out,</u> a copy of which is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit "E-1"</u>.

Ms. Duncan reviewed and discussed outsourcing bill printing and mail out services for the District.

Upon motion by Director Eason, seconded by Director Cantu, after full discussion and with all Directors present voting aye, the Board approved the creation of a committee and authorized said committee to review and approve the outsource of bill printing and mail out services; the Committee consists of Director Holder, Director Parra, and General Manager Ms. Duncan.

Upon motion by Director Eason, seconded by Director Cantu, after full discussion and with all Directors present voting aye, the Board approved the General Manager's Report.
